NAPLAN

The NAPLAN tests will be held in week 2 of this term for all students in Years 3, 5 and 7 from Tuesday 9th to Thursday 11th May. This year tests will be administered simultaneously in all schools across Australia. Aspects of literacy assessed are reading, writing and language conventions (comprising spelling, punctuation and grammar) while numeracy testing includes number, algebra, function and pattern, measurement, chance and data and space.

The test schedule is as follows:

Tuesday 9th May - Language Conventions and Writing

Wednesday 10th May - Reading

Thursday 11th May - Numeracy

Students who miss one day of testing due to illness may make up the test/s on Friday 12th May 2017.
